

BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1

MINUTES OF
April 9, 2018

CALL TO ORDER:

The regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order by President Nelson at 8:04 p.m. President Nelson announced that the meeting is being held in compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act". Public Notice of this meeting was hand delivered to the Clerk of the Township of Ocean and posted at the Oakhurst Firehouse on March 7, 2018, and advertised in The Coaster and in the Atlanticville on March 7, 2018.

After a salute to the flag, a moment of silence was observed.

ATTENDANCE:

The following Board members were present: Russ Williams, John Morrow, Scott Nelson and Stu Newman. Fire District Administrator / Fire Marshal Craig Flannigan, District Mechanic Chris Sorrentino and Fire Department Officers also attended. Commissioner Reu could not attend.

MINUTES:

Nelson - Minutes of the previous meetings were placed on the table for everyone's review, comments or corrections. There were no questions or corrections pertaining to the March 26, 2018 monthly meeting minutes. Nelson moved for them to be accepted as written. It was second by Williams. There were no questions to the motion. Roll call vote of was unanimous.

EXPENSES:

Newman - The Bills were reviewed by the Commissioners prior to the meeting and found to be OK. Copies of the bill list were on the table for anyone to review. Newman offered a motion to pay the Bills totaling \$45,212.12. It was seconded Williams. There were no questions. Roll call vote of yes was unanimous in favor of the Resolution.

DISTRICT NO. 1 ORGANIZATION's REPORTS:

Chief Fiorentino: Chief's report for the month of March. He reported 81 activities for the month. Average response time was 3 minutes 6 seconds. Average firefighters per call were 10, for a total of 817 members responding, experiencing 177 total man-hours. Mutual aid was given 7 times and received 0 times.

- Hose & Ground ladder testing April 23 & 24 at Sears
- Pump testing April 25 at station 2
