CALL TO ORDER:

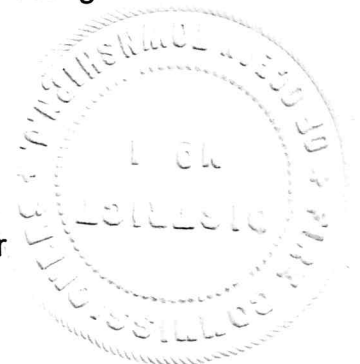
NEW BUSINESS:
